The couch and master bed are often great places for family and sibling shots. I completely understand what it's like to have a newborn baby. Please don't worry about cleaning the house before I get there. We can easily tidy up any space we want to use.

Your Baby: I am so honored to be able to photograph this new little life. Your baby is beautiful and perfect just the way he or she is. I am here to freeze time for just a moment. With that in mind, simple is best. A simple, snug onesie with no graphics or words will help make these images timeless. If you would like to gather some favorite swaddle blankets, that would be great. I will have some larger white or creamy blankets to ensure a neutral background. It's a good idea to feed your baby about 15 minutes before I get there. We will take our time. I am not in any rush. We will follow your baby's lead throughout the session and preserve this very unique and special time in your life.

Siblings: Siblings are such an important part of a baby's life. We will try to get sibling and family photos soon after I arrive - before they lose interest. Again, there are no expectations here. My job is to capture the personalities and connections that your family already has with your newborn.

Mom & Dad: I know how stressful it is to have a new baby. Your job throughout the session is to simply relax and soak up this moment. If there is an image you really want, let me know. I love to collaborate with my clients. I will take pictures of both of you *together* with your baby and both you *individually* with your baby. I like lots of snuggles, and lots of slowing down and enjoying this really beautiful time.

Wardrobe: It's a good idea to stick to neutral colors – whites, creams, greys, etc.. Solids are great. The most important thing is for you to be comfortable.
